## 17<sup>th</sup> Street Softball

### Local Rules:

- Mercy Rule - 15 after 5 innings  
Playoffs – 15 after 5 innings
- Home Runs: A – 6 Progressive B – 4 Progressive C - 3 Progressive
- Courtesy Foul for A & B & C Division get a courtesy foul
- Screen must cover  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the rubber, and be 3 feet in front of rubber. If ball hits screen – foul ball, after that it is courtesy foul ball. If pitcher touches ball, then it goes into the screen, dead ball, batter & baserunners advance one base
- Player Fee: Games 1-8 \$30 after game 9 - \$10 Team fees - \$375
- Roster – must be on roster by game 8 to be eligible for playoffs
- Roster - signing a new player, player must sign the roster before the game & pay player fee to be able to play, if player does not, the other team can protest using an illegal player after the final out, if player is determined illegal the game will be declared a forfeit for team using illegal player
- Senior Bats are illegal, if player is using a senior bat and the other team or ump is made aware, the batter can switch to a legal bat, if the at bat is completed, the player will be called out and baserunners return to their bases.
- Playoffs – No time limit for games
- Playoffs – Higher seeded team is Home Team
- Playoffs - no subs allowed, if a team has used an illegal player the league will determine if player was illegal and the team using illegal player will forfeit the game. Players must have ID
- Playoffs winning team gets one shirt per player eligible on roster. Will be decided at Managers Meeting if league will provide shirts.
- Subs – Regular season - Teams can select players from other teams to avoid a forfeit only adding up to 10 maximum, your players must play before adding subs.  
No subs allowed after the 3rd inning is completed.

- Games can begin with 8 players – (John’s Rule)
- Courtesy Runner, each team can have one, must let umpire know before At Bat begins, after one courtesy is selected, must remain courtesy for whole game. If team wants another courtesy runner, Umpire will ask approval from opposing team manager, if approved last out becomes the runner, if batter reaches first base. Umpire keeps track of courtesy runners and announces before At Bat begins, runner must turn to the right if safe at first, any move to advance towards 2<sup>nd</sup> base, Umpire will call the runner out. Courtesy can hit Home Run. If batter reaches a base, and then would like to have a courtesy runner, Umpire will ask for opposing team Manager’s approval.
- Pinch Runner - A pinch runner can enter for one runner on base, per inning, if that pinch runner is on base and they are then at bat, they will be called out, and leave the base they were on. If a team uses more than one pinch runner in the same inning, as soon as the 2<sup>nd</sup> pinch runner touches the base, that runner is out, other runners stay at their bases, Manager must let ump know using 2<sup>nd</sup> illegal pinch runner, and Ump will call out.
- Ejections – If a player is ejected from a game, they must leave the field, go to the parking lot, and will not be able to play in the team’s next game.
- F Bombs will get a warning, if said again player is ejected.
- Only rostered players allowed in dugouts. Music will not be played during games. Only players allowed on field if playing in the scheduled game.
- No Glass Bottles allowed inside the complex.
- Fighting will not be tolerated, and will be reviewed by the Board, and could result in a season suspension.
